- Liaise with the Board, through an assigned point person, to have new initiatives reviewed and obtain feedback/approval.

- Organize the Student Ambassador core team meetings, assignment of tasks and accountability updates.
- Develop a succession plan for your position to create a seamless transition in leadership

The position will involve several hours per month with more time allocated when the group is more active and more in the fall and winter than in the summer
